

# Managing Pop-ups in Safari

## Summary

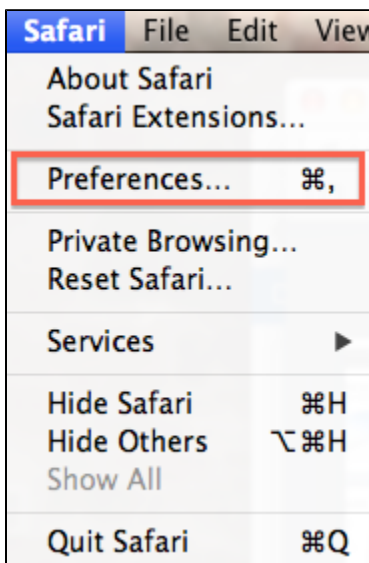
Pop-up blockers prevent unwanted web pages from appearing on your screen while browsing the internet. However, sometimes necessary pop-ups are blocked by the system. The pop-up blocker can be disabled for certain sites. This article gives instructions on how to turn on/off the Pop-up Blocker and how to allow pop-ups for specific websites on Safari.

## Disabling and Enabling Pop-up Blocker

Safari does not have an "allowed sites" function. To enable popups only for certain websites in Safari, you will have to turn off the pop-up blocker while on the site and turn it on again when leaving the site.

1. Open Safari and select **Preferences** from the Safari menu.



2. Select **Security**. You can enable pop-up blocker by selecting the checkbox **Block pop-up windows**, or disable pop-up blocker by deselecting it.
