An officer is on duty at the west entrance to the campus beginning at 8 p.m. Free parking is available on campus (also at off-campus locations) in well lighted lots. On-campus (3900 and at Anderson Center) students will be escorted to their cars after class upon request. All primary officers are trained in first aid, CPR, and AED implementation.
