

Student Conduct Board Policy

A Student Conduct Board process exists for the purpose of assisting the Office of Student Life with adjudicating College of Arts and Sciences student conduct violations. A Student Conduct Board may be convened at the request of the College of Arts and Sciences dean of student programs for the purpose of hearing and making a recommendation on student conduct matters that would likely lead to the expulsion, dismissal, suspension, and removal from campus housing of students enrolled in the College of Arts and Sciences. A Student Conduct Board will comprise faculty, staff, and students trained specifically for this role in the student conduct process.
